Meadowscaping helps to educate you on how to become better gardeners, integrate more native plants into your garden for biodiversity, and help pollinators to preserve the natural ecosystem.

We point you in the right direction, show you how to get started, what to plant in your designated area, and how to care for the garden to enjoy your Meadow.

Labor is provided by MS4B staff and students in our Youth Environmental Entrepreneurship Program.

### **PLAN A**

- 1 hour consultation:
  - Designated area measurement - site assessment (Sun/shade area - recommendation soil test)
  - Fees: \$150.- includes initial 1/2 hour free.

### **PLAN B**

- Includes Plan A
- Research and selection of plants for the native plant garden or meadow
- Preliminary design
- Purchase of plants from our catalog.
- Fees: \$550

### PLAN C

- Includes Plan A & B
- Final Native Plant Garden design with approval of selected plants.
- Cost: \$800

### PLAN D

- Remove Invasives:
  - \$50 -- 2 people
  - \$75 – 3 people
  - \$100 – 4 people

### Add our labor:

- Per student labor: \$25/hour.
- Purchase of plants (see catalog online for prices)
- Delivery \$75

### OPTIONAL

- New soil (Optional) \$45 per cubic yard plus delivery
- Invasive plant removal: \$25 an hour. (We don't remove Poison Ivy)
